Paid out to one and all from birth to death on an individual basis, without resource control or quid pro quo, it holds out the vision of a safer, fairer society.

But a UBI is a complicated project and several competing versions exist, at times dovetailing with proposals to get rid of social welfare and other protections. The organization MFRB (French Movement for a UBI) provides an overview of this important idea, informed by the many experiments performed in its name, the better to make it a tool for a truly liberating revolution.
