This is the beginning of a grand exploration of memory, which brings to light both the collective history of "coolie trade" and the intimate history of Nathacha Appanah's family. The center of the book is a magnificent tribute to her grandfather, whose beauty and courage illuminate these pages. Like his own father, he worked in the cane fields, respecting Hindu traditions but feeling, more than anything else, Mauritian.
